RE: **Annual Notification/Three-Year Asbestos Re-inspections**

The Beachwood City School District, like other schools, participated in asbestos removal activities beginning in 1985. All accessible friable (easily crumbled) materials were removed from the schools at this time. In 1987 new federal regulations were issued that required schools to thoroughly inspect and submit a management plan by October 12, 1988 to address materials that remained in school buildings. Additionally, federal law also requires schools to do a thorough reinspection every three years.

Three-year reinspections were completed in: September 1991, July 1994, August 1997, July 2000, August 2003, July 2006 and June of 2009. As a part of our effort to comply with federal mandates, materials were identified that need continuing monitoring and each material's condition was recorded.

If any member of the public is interested, inspection reports and the management plan are available for review by appointment during regular business hours. If you wish to see the report, please contact the building principal for an appointment. All appointment requests will be honored within five working days of their receipt. A copy of the inspection/management plan is also available by request through the Board of Education.
